❖ **Feature Articles**

Theoretical, scientific and research manuscripts detailing original health research findings collected within the last three years, or health promotion/disease prevention programming and policies at Minority-Serving Institutions (including Historically Black Colleges and Universities, Hispanic-Serving Institutions, Tribal Colleges and Universities, and International academic institutions).

❖ **Rising Stars Spotlight**

Biographical sketches and unique accomplishments of health professionals and community stakeholders committed to progressing health promotion and disease prevention among emerging adult populations at MSIs. Interviews of selectees will be conducted by the Institute for Successful Leadership.

❖ **Perspectives**

Perspectives is a forum for opinions on ethical, social, institutional, professional or historical issues affecting application and implementation of health promotion programming at MSIs. Also, articles submitted in this category will focus on maintaining life-work balance, comprehensive wellness and community leadership among health professionals.

**Rising Stars** nominations should be no more than 200 words and identify innovative aspects of nominee's research, program implementation or career perspectives. Contact information including phone number and email address for the nominee is also requested.

**Conference** submissions should include event contact information (including contact names, phone numbers and website addresses) and detail key components of meeting topics, locations, meeting dates, registration costs, scholarship availability and registration deadlines.

**Funding and Collaboration Opportunities** should detail contexts and purposes of funding opportunities, eligibility requirements and submission deadlines.
